

Regulatory model



Bill #2.338

- Proposed on May 3, 2023
- Currently under public hearings and consultations
- Not likely to be approved in 2023

DPA regulatory sandbox on Al

- Risk based approach
- Similar to the EU
- Recent discussions heavily criticized the regulatory model
- DPA sandbox content to be defined

International Data Transfer Modalities

ANPD adequacy decision

International Cooperation Agreement

When the controller offers and proves guarantees of compliance with the principles and the rights of the data subject and the regime of data protection provided in the LGPD:

- Specific contractual clauses for a given transfer (will potentially be defined as "subsidiary modality");
- Standard contractual clauses* (template under discussion);
- Binding corporate rules;
- Regularly issued stamps, certificates and codes of conduct;

Additionally:

- Necessary to protect the life or physical safety of the data subject or of a third party;
- National authority authorizes the transfer;
- Transfer results in a commitment undertaken through international cooperation;
- Transfer is necessary for the execution of a public policy or legal attribution of public service, which shall be publicized;
- When the data subject has given her/his specific and highlighted **consent for the transfer**, with prior information about the international nature of the operation, with this being clearly distinct from other purposes;
- or when it is necessary to satisfy the situations provided in law(e.g. legal obligation, lawsuits)

Regulation of International Transfer of Personal Data

Public consultation deadline: October 14, 2023

Possibility of acknowledging other SCCs compatible with LGPD and therefore, no need to update the IDT mechanism

- Equivalence of personal data protection of a foreign country (adequacy decision)
- Standard contractual clauses (SCCs)
- Customized contractual clauses for each data transfer (SUBSIDIARY MODALITY)
- Binding global corporate rules

Adequacy Decision

The analysis of the level of equivalence considers:

General and sectoral rules

Nature of the data


Data protection and suject rights principles

Adoption of security measures

Judicial safeguards

The ANPD has not issued any decisions on the matter Likely follow the same line as the EU's approach There has been reported discussions with the UK on the topic

Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)



Compliance with the Brazilian regulation on international data transfer

Record of Processing Activities (ROPA)

Risk Assessment, considering International Data Transfers Manage the agreements with third parties regarding international data transfer

Prepare a communication channel for data subjects requests (DSR)

Security incidents policy

Corporate rules

Third-party management (processors)

Identify the parties involved

Identify the data being transferred (national and international) and the purpose

Analyze the agreement between the parties


